HOW CAN YOU PARTICIPATE?

The best way to ensure that landscape architects have a vital role in planning and designing for our communities is to promote a broad understanding of our profession and increase awareness of our contribution to Canada. Here are a number of things you can do to participate in our celebrations.

POST THE CSLA 2009 LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTURE MONTH POSTER

The poster selected for World Landscape Architecture Month 2009 was designed by Sylvie Godin of Montreal, Quebec. Ms. Godin graduated from Université de Montréal in 2007, with a bachelor degree in landscape architecture. She is a Member (*probationer*) of the AAPQ.

- Post the 2009 Landscape Architecture Month poster in schools, libraries, recreation centers and other
 public buildings in your community. Request a hard copy from your component, or print off your own
 copies by downloading the poster from the CSLA website (See PRINTING INSTRUCTIONS)
- Print postcards of the poster for mass mailing.
- Email the digital file of the poster to your clients and colleagues.
- Use the poster as wallpaper on your computer screen for the month of April.

HOST AN EVENT IN YOUR COMMUNITY

With the poster spread throughout communities across Canada, the CSLA has prepared **suggestions of how you can celebrate** the profession by **hosting an event to celebrate landscape architecture** in your community.

- Use the Landscape Architecture Month power point presentation template to make a presentation in your community. Request a copy of the power point template from the CSLA or your component, or download your own file from the CSLA website.
- Contact your local high school principal or guidance councilor to volunteer with career discovery programs in your community.
- Volunteer to speak about landscape architecture at a local school or youth organization.
- Serve as a mentor to a student who may be considering landscape architecture among their career
 options, or to a student already studying in landscape architecture or a related program.
- Offer a volunteer work opportunity in your landscape architecture office to local high school students, or to help students meet volunteer hour requirements to obtain their diplomas.
- Organize a tree planting or a clean-up campaign in your local park or along a riverbank with your municipality or local community associations. Aim to hold your event in conjunction with Earth Day on April 22nd.
