Synthesis 2015 is the product of a two-year collaboration led by Ouranos that mobilized more than 100 experts from all domains related to climate change. The experts coordinated and collected information, and wrote and reviewed the document's various chapters. With more than 1,000 references and citations, the synthesis provides a comprehensive overview of existing knowledge on climate evolution, vulnerabilities and impacts, as well on progress made on adaptation, in all areas of interest to Québec.
