The CSLA Board of Governors requested that the OALA Representative chair a committee on CSLA Media Access and Marketing concerns. The marketing strategy which was subsequently proposed to the Board of Governors contained the following recommendations:

- ❖ Audit the CSLA component associations with respect to existing marketing resources, key issues and target markets.
- ❖ Promote the CSLA as a Resource House of marketing tools.
- ❖ Promote communication with the CSLA component associations.
- ❖ Promote the CSLA Annual Awards Program.
- ❖ Enhance the national profile of the profession by supporting an appropriate national program and by raising funds for a chosen charity.
- ❖ Initiate a National Advertising Campaign (a task which would involve a substantial budget and thus may not be readily achievable in the short term).

A review was undertaken of the practical relationship between the CSLA and a host association in the planning of a CSLA Annual Conference. The review addressed the definition and re-establishment of areas of responsibility, and the development of a more realistic approach to financial concerns.

Currently, the various marketing contacts for each of the CSLA component associations have been contacted and requested to complete a marketing survey. The intention is to coordinate the sharing of marketing information among the associations and to reduce duplication of efforts in marketing.

In addition to identifying the marketing efforts undertaken by each CSLA component association, the survey requested information on the perceived marketing needs of each association. The results of this survey will be used as the basis for development of a CSLA Resource Manual for Marketing, and will in part determine whether or not a marketing consultant will need to be involved in the preparation of the manual.

The 1993 annual meeting of the Landscape Architecture Canada Foundation (LACF) was held in Montreal, Quebec, at the time of the Annual CSLA Congress. The financial report indicated that donations and other revenues were up from \$8,037 to \$10,034 in 1992. Total assets stood at \$36,646 at that time. Business included the appointment of Gunter Schoch, FCSLA, as Treasurer; a discussion on fundraising strategies; and the establishment of grants policy for the coming year.

The LACF completed its second formal round of consideration of requests for grant proposals in the fall of 1993. The objective of this program is to support research, education and communications in the field of landscape architecture. The Grants Committee, chaired by Cecelia Paine, included Don Graham, Gary Hilderman, John MacLeod, and Len Novak.

This year six proposals were received and we are pleased to announce the following grants:

- To Charlie Thomsen, FCSLA, Professor of Landscape Architecture at the University of Manitoba, \$1,000 to develop a "Guidebook to Historic Landscapes of Manitoba". This document will use the material included in

an exhibit (shown in Winnipeg and at the CSLA Congress in Montreal) which illustrates significant designed and vernacular landscapes in the Province.

- To Linda LeGeyst, \$1,000 to help support "Oral history interviews of senior Canadian practitioners of landscape architecture". This project will involve interviewing twenty landscape architects with the intent of collecting information about their knowledge and ideas regarding the practice of landscape architecture in Canada. This historic perspective will provide a data base for a manuscript for publication and will serve as a reference source for future researchers.

It should be noted that the requests were of a high calibre this year, and that proposals will be invited again in September for the next round of grants.

The 1994 annual meeting of the LACF will be held in Victoria, BC, in conjunction with the CSLA Congress in March.

Since the inception of the CSLA, a total of 82 members have been honoured by investiture to Fellowship, 14 of whom are now deceased.

The College conducted its Annual Meeting during Congress '93 with 20 Fellows in attendance. At the meeting it was decided to continue and expand the 'Campaign of Fellows', which was originally intended for a five year period (1989-93). During this time, over \$33,000 has been donated by Fellows to the Landscape Architecture Canada Foundation. The College receives reports annually from the Foundation, the Accreditation Council and the Archives project. At this meeting it was also decided to collect personal profile information of all Fellows, including resumes, photographs, and articles through the Secretary-Treasurer's office.

The Annual Meeting was also used to conduct an election, approving Alexander Budrevics as Vice-Chair of the College for 1994-96, followed by his chairmanship from 1996-98. Presently, the College Executive consists of the following individuals:

The External Affairs Committee of the CSLA is embarking on a program to establish liaisons with national and international organizations and government agencies which have relevance to landscape architecture.

## The Manitoba Association of Landscape Architects

As of December 31, 1993, the Manitoba Association of Landscape Architects' membership consisted of 42 full and inactive members. Of these, 21 (50%) were working in private practice, 13 (31%) for government agencies, 5 (12%) at universities and 3 (7%) were retired.

### Strategic Plan

Following numerous Council and membership meetings in 1992, MALA's Strategic Plan was formally adopted at the 1993 Annual Meeting. The document consists of a mission statement, statement of goals, strategic initiatives and a statement of continuous objectives. The plan defines the issues facing the profession in Manitoba and establishes priorities for the Association's activities during the next five years and beyond.

### Promotion of the Profession

A number of goals set out in the Strategic Plan are being accomplished through MALA's ambitious community service project, the Red River Corridor Study. As a gift to the City of Winnipeg, a conceptual master plan for an 11 km long riverbank parkway is being developed jointly with the Department of Landscape Architecture at the University of Manitoba. The first phase included comprehensive analysis and identification of opportunities and constraints, tasks that were addressed as part of a planning and design studio by students which was completed in 1993. Students, professors, private and public sector landscape architects are now combining their talents to produce the final document. Public meetings were conducted in different neighbourhoods affected by this project. In addition, presentations were made to standing committees of the Winnipeg City Council to gain political support for the project.

In February 1993, for the second consecutive year, MALA participated in the annual three-day Career Symposium at the Winnipeg Convention Centre. An impressive exhibit was again organized and staffed by students and practitioners.

As they have in the previous four years, MALA members participated as tour guides to school groups in the Archibus Program, a component of City Week '93. Archibus remains an important part of MALA's community service efforts.

### Professional Name Act

In November 1993, the Manitoba Law Reform Commission issued its long awaited discussion paper on "The Future of Occupational Regulations in Manitoba". The Commission's recommendations are strongly based on structures established in other provinces, primarily Quebec and Alberta. Accordingly, the Commission is recommending that "regulations should only be imposed in response to clear threat of substantial harm to the public". MALA is considering the submission of a response by the March 1, 1994 deadline.

Meanwhile, with the assistance of the Manitoba Association of Architects, MALA has been successful in convincing the Manitoba Telephone System to restrict listings under the "Landscape Architects" heading in its Yellow Pages Directory to members of the Association. This is considered a giant step towards title control, perhaps as far as MALA will ever be able to advance.

### Professional Development

The Professional Development Committee was established in 1992 to serve all four design professions in Manitoba. In 1993, the Committee was actively engaged in organizing seminars on "Emerging Trends within the Design and Planning Professions" and "Strategic Marketing of the Professional Design Practice". It also supported a research project titled "Impact of Change: Design in an Uncertain Realm" and coordinated a second "Business Fundamentals Course for Planning and Design Professionals" at the University of Manitoba.

### University Liaison

In May 1993, the MALA Gold Medal was awarded to a graduating student for highest achievements in landscape architectural studies at the University of Manitoba. This year's recipient was Mr. Darryl N. Zoerb.

In November, at a 'Department of Landscape Architecture Appreciation Night', the annual MALA Awards of Merit were presented to 6 students for outstanding achievements during the 1992/93 academic year. The Landscape Architecture Student Association also received special recognition.

The University Liaison Committee, consisting of MALA's President and Vice-President, has conducted regular meetings with the Head of the Department of Landscape Architecture throughout the year to discuss issues of mutual concern.

## Other Activities

The APALA Executive is currently developing a new Members' Manual for prospective new members.

APALA members in Nova Scotia are addressing proposed legislation by the City of Halifax requiring that all grading plans be stamped by an Engineer. APALA is arguing that the key issue relates to competency in erosion control and sedimentation, and not simply to an Engineering qualification.

APALA is financially participating in a Clean

Annapolis River Project - Partnership with local groups and government to put environmental stewardship in the hands of the community.

New Brunswick members have been trying to promote their expertise in the areas of Environmental Assessment, Highway Construction and School projects, realms which have not traditionally been open to landscape architects.

While focusing primarily on environmental legislation and marketing over the past year, the APALA has also continued to address such issues as reciprocity, continuing education and membership by-laws.

tion and membership requirements should continue to evolve to meet or match professional registration requirements of the other professions".

The survey results of the associate members were not surprisingly quite different, with a 53% majority feeling that graduation from an accredited school in addition to a specified length of work experience should be sufficient pre-qualification to meet with the Board of Examiners. Only 31% agreed with the decision to adopt the LARE, but 68% felt the membership requirements should meet or match other professions.

## Fee Brochure

The BCSLA fee guide (Recommended Conditions of Engagement and Methods of Remuneration) has been reviewed and upgraded. The significant changes have been "a clearer and more explicit definition of the scope of work covered by a percentage fee", "clarification of work extra to the percentage" such as pre-design tasks, project management and contract administration, or the "liaison and coordination of the numerous governmental agencies and statutory authorities, the organization and attendance of public participation meetings, and attendance of multi-discipline project meetings".

## CLARB

Forty-three (43) Associate Members wrote the LARE (BCSLA pre-exam) in 1993. Twelve (12) passed the subsequent Board of Examiners review. Revenues related to the examinations were \$24,288 and expenses were \$28,638.

## Budget for 1994

The BCSLA anticipates revenues of \$131,045 and expenses of \$127,785 in 1993, making possible a contribution of \$3,087 to the reserve fund. We will be implementing a fee increase of ± 2% of regular membership fees, resulting in a new fee total of \$476.15.

## Issues

The BCSLA Board of Directors has completed a survey of the membership to examine the issues of membership requirements and examination formats. Both regular and associate members were contacted, and although forms are still being returned, sufficient numbers are available to gain an understanding of the overall results.

A series of questions were designed to gauge the feelings of the membership regarding the importance of the current (or any other) exam process. Of the regular members who responded to the survey, 68% felt that an exam such as the LARE or the previous BCSLA exam should be required as part of the pre-qualification necessary to meet with the Board of Examiners. A significant group was either unsatisfied (20%) or unsure (23%) that the BCSLA decision to adopt the LARE was a correct one. A 77% majority felt that the "examina-

### Professional Development Strategic Plan

The AAPQ Board of Directors enthusiastically accepted the professional development report submitted by Carole Beauregard (Fernet) early in the year. After the report was reviewed, four main thrusts of intervention were identified for the AAPQ to implement in 1993:

- ◆ To conquer markets;
- ◆ To improve the profession's visibility;
- ◆ To develop professional expertise;
- ◆ To promote excellence.

Three successful presentation meetings were held in Montreal, Quebec City and Hull in November 1993. Satisfied with the quality of the work presented in the plan, several members volunteered to join action committees on each of the four thrusts. We will be better able to assess the fruits of our labour in 1994.

### Visibility of the Profession and Community Services

The Contest "Villes, villages et campagnes fleuris" (VVCF - Cities, Towns and Countryside in Full Bloom) once again served to promote the AAPQ, as jury members from the AAPQ did an outstanding job and the IRIS Award, an award of excellence in landscape architecture inaugurated by the AAPQ in 1992, was presented. The award is given to four (4) winning municipalities.

Forum Design Montréal (FDM), of which the AAPQ is a member, was awarded a grant for a study that will determine the economic value of "design" as an element that contributes to society's economic development.

The Pacijou Project, an educational program, was carried out this year with the collaboration of John MacLeod and Lise Cormier. Pacijou is a psychological education group whose mission is to encourage healthy, non-violent behaviour in public schools.

Six (6) schools participated in the program during which children designed peace parks that are suitable for schoolyards and that both emphasize non-violent behaviour and promote cooperation. Vincent Dumais, AAPQ President, presented certificates to the winning junior landscape architects during a news conference. Pacijou hopes to offer the program on an annual basis.

### Promoting Excellence

In 1993, the AAPQ organized, or participated in, several events to promote excellence in landscape architecture, including granting scholarships to graduates of the School of Landscape Architecture and honouring the IRIS Award winners (VVCF Contest). CSLA regional and national professional awards were showcased in several ways: at press conferences, during an exposition at the University of Montreal held in collaboration with the School of Landscape Architecture, and, of course, at Congress '93.

The AAPQ set a precedent as far as hosting CSLA Congress is concerned. The CSLA Professional Awards were handed to the winners during the opening evening of Congress '93, at the Vieux-Port in Montréal. Over 100 people (special guests and participants) were on hand for the occasion. The opening evening was an excellent promotional tool for landscape architecture.

### Continuing Education

The AAPQ offered its members a variety of continuing education courses in 1993: Landcadd, computer assisted landscape designs, 3D modelling in landscape architecture, and marketing. A survey will soon be conducted among members in order to evaluate their immediate training needs.



When I applied for the position of Executive Director of the CSLA, I thought that I had a fairly good understanding of the workings of the Society. After all, I have been both Treasurer and President and over the past few years have had the opportunity to become involved in a variety of Society projects. However, I had no idea of the tremendous amount of effort that was required to run this machine and how fickle and fragile it is. Under the steady hands of my predecessors there was an enviable record of accomplishments to try and build upon, and over 1100 members (read "bosses") who needed to be recognized. Well, it has been quite a year. I've gained many new insights into how a national organization functions, learned a lot, travelled a bit, made many new friends and worked hard to meet my commitments to the Board of Governors and the membership. I have had the privilege of working with Presidents Clark and Melvin and, together with the Board of Governors, many volunteers and especially the Executive Secretary Linda Le Geyt, we have been able to accomplish a great deal. The following are some of the highlights.

The day to day activities of the Society come under the watchful eye of Linda Le Geyt whose bright smile and capable approach make my job as Executive Director an easy one. As everyone on the Board can attest, there is now regular communication with each member and the business operations have been significantly improved. A major focus of Linda's activity has been to refine the roster and mailing labels so that they are as accurate as possible. As a result of these efforts there has been a great reduction in the number of returns following mail outs such as the Bulletin; returns have gone from over a hundred to less than ten.

The next focus has been on the production and preparation of membership certificates. Each component association was contacted and on the basis of the names provided we have now prepared a total of 148 certificates for presentation to the members. We are now current with this program and can respond promptly and efficiently to member requirements.

Recently, numerous boxes of accumulated information were sorted and indexed, and archival materials filed at the University of Guelph in care of Professor Jack Milliken. Minutes of old meetings will be scanned into computer files so that we will have easy access to information on any topic of interest to the Board or the general membership.

Lapel pins based upon the logo of the Society were produced and distributed to the component associations for distribution to the members and for use in promotional ventures.

The new Brochure on the profession has been completed and is in the process of being distributed. The text was prepared with the help of many individuals across the country, including one of our Founding Members, Humphrey Carver, who was a great help with the history component.

International liaison has continued to evolve with the Mexicans, Americans and members of the Alliance. Our minutes of the Montreal Alliance meeting helped form the basis for further discussions between members, and aided the IFLA reorganization committee with the formulation of a plan of reunification.

As a component in this Annual Report, you will find a summary of the expenditures of the Society for 1993 and the approved budget for 1994.

The focus over the next year will be to continue to develop a greater efficiency within the office and to develop resource files for all subjects which are of interest to the membership, beginning with accreditation and reciprocity.

In the near future the Board will define a Canadian position and begin affirmative action to support that decision ... stay tuned.

The beginning of my term as President is fast approaching and I am indebted to many of you who have assisted in my "learning experience" over the past year. Individuals make the organization strong and effective. Without people like Jim Melvin, Larry Paterson, Linda LeGeyt and the members of the current Board of Governors, I would not be able or ready to undertake the task that lies ahead.

I look forward to meeting many of you during the coming year, hopefully at Congress '94 in Victoria.

As many CSLA members may notice, this Annual Report is the inaugural issue of the CSLA Bulletin under the newly instated editorship of the undersigned, Rodger Todhunter.

With the recent suspension of the Landscape Architectural Review, we are without a national journal to facilitate the dissemination of ideas, the discussion of issues and the coverage of events of national importance. While it will not be the intention of the Bulletin to replace the LA Review, which will hopefully re-emerge in the future, there is a short to medium term vacuum to be filled. Under my guidance and with CSLA member support, hopefully we can expand the breadth and mandate of the Bulletin to make it more than a periodic newsletter.

This Annual Report introduces a new graphic format for the Bulletin, and subsequent issues will see the addition of the following features as standard Bulletin items. New items we intend to introduce include:

### ❖ Specific Content Themes

We propose to "theme" issues based on specific topics. For the next three issues we intend to have feature articles, reviews, and letters related to the following topics:

#### ❖ Competitions

*The next issue will feature the Confederation Birthplace Commemorative Park (Charlottetown) competition and the Uptown Core (Oakville) competition. Designs will be illustrated, and the strengths and weaknesses of the competition process, both with respect to these competitions and in general, will be highlighted in a series of critical articles. We would appreciate any comments from CSLA members on this topic. Appropriate material will be published in the next issue of the Bulletin.*

#### ❖ Government Agencies

*Across Canada, municipal, provincial and federal agencies provide a wide range of landscape architectural related services. In this issue we hope to profile some of the activities of our most important national organizations such as the National Capital Commission, Parks Canada and Environment Canada. Significant provincial agencies such as the Ministry of Transportation in Ontario or British Columbia may be profiled. Efforts of progressive municipal government agencies or Task Forces such as the Crombie Commission could also be covered.*

*The undertakings of various government agencies will be highlighted, as well as their potential shortcomings. Are governments representing our profession or are we being ignored? What is the role of the government in the profession? A wide range of topics and perspectives are possible in this issue.*

#### ❖ Canadian Schools

*Each university and college program in landscape architecture across Canada is contributing to the future strength of our profession. We intend to profile all the landscape architectural programs across Canada in terms of the size and scope of each department, key faculty members, notable accomplishments, and the philosophy or focus of each faculty or program. Relevant issues which members wish to raise with respect to education, including strengths and weaknesses of specific programs or approaches, will also be considered for publication.*

#### ❖ Future Themes

*Attached is a Reader Survey which we are asking you to fill out in order to assist us in identifying themes, issues and topics suitable for publication in the Bulletin.*

### ❖ Critical Articles / Book Reviews

Members are encouraged to submit articles, critical essays or book reviews (up to 2000 words) addressing significant issues, projects or publications of interest to CSLA members. Submissions will be reviewed by designated CSLA members with respect to suitability for publication.

#### ❖ Member Notes

With well over one thousand members, our readers must be constantly making changes. Have you closed your practice and moved into the balmy climes of Victoria or Florida? Have you opened up a new consulting firm, embarked on an academic career, or won a professional award? Keep us and your colleagues across Canada up to date as to your activities. Most provincial newsletters provide this service, and the CSLA should further disseminate this type of information. Once again, please write or fax us so we can publish this information.

The CSLA Bulletin will only be as good as you, the members, want it to be. Therefore, if you feel you would like to contribute ideas or articles, please fill in the attached survey, and/or fax or write to us. We would also like to establish a series of regional correspondents who can keep us posted on the activities of their component associations.

In closing, while the next few issues will be challenging, we will attempt to provide the CSLA with an improved method of critical communication and dialogue. With your support, this will be a successful and rewarding undertaking.

- ❖ Review by the Membership Task Force of membership policy and proposed expansion of categories of CSLA membership.
- ❖ Review of the length of tenure of Board of Governor membership.
- ❖ Financial support of an Oral History Project which documents the accomplishments and memories of selected distinguished Canadian landscape architects.
- ❖ Membership in the National Design Alliance.

The Board recently approved, through efforts of the National Design Alliance, a national sector study on the profession of Landscape Architecture in Canada. This work will be funded by the Federal Department of Human Resources and Immigration. All members and component organizations are encouraged to cooperate with

the consultants conducting the survey. This study will examine the current status of landscape architecture, employment characteristics, technology impact, education and training, and competitiveness. The study's conclusions may direct future efforts and suggest specific actions essential to the maintenance and enhancement of the profession in the future.

These are but a few of the items discussed and reviewed in the course of the last year. The agendas are full, and the social breaks well deserved. Everyone should have the opportunity to experience the wealth of knowledge and the personalities associated with the national and international landscape architectural community. It has indeed been an honour to serve as your president during the past year.

As a regional Member of CSLA I had been concerned and somewhat critical of the Society. It has taken a term of activity within the CSLA to make me aware of the important role it plays within national and international affairs. I am converted. I have been greatly impressed with the regional representatives who have contributed their time and experience to keep the CSLA responsive, effective, and focused. The CSLA has provided the membership with a diverse and important national presence and is of infinite value to the regional components and individual members. My Mandate will attempt to focus on the national issues, specifically the current 3-year program and development of the succeeding one, communications, reciprocity, service awards, and to a lesser extent, IFLA.

### Communications

Of the various programs provided by CSLA, of greatest importance should be national-scale communication to the membership. Rodger Todhunter has recently been appointed the new Editor of the Bulletin and this is his first issue. We all wish Rodger well and I hope that each Member will assist him as the opportunity arises. CSLA is currently attempting to find an appropriate national journal for the profession in Canada. The Editorial Board is currently exploring alternatives and hopefully we will resolve this item over the next few months.

### Reciprocity

A Reciprocity Task Force is currently being established to attempt to resolve this very difficult and pressing issue. The Board of Governors will meet during Congress '94 in Victoria to study the major issues and provide ideas for resolution. This has been a very difficult issue to study, much less resolve, due to the diverse membership standards and categories that are found across Canada, and the international implications of programs such as NAFTA that will directly affect our decisions.

### Service Awards

The 1992-93 Service Award Programs are proving very successful. The President's Award is fast becoming the most prestigious award offered by the profession to recognize service and dedication to the Society. The Student silver medal is presently being minted and will provide an increased opportunity for student recognition and an improved profile for the profession. The medals will replace the minimal cash awards of past years.

CSLA is currently working with the College of Fellows to define a new Fellows medal. The Regional Awards Program is underway this year and will provide a means for the society and regional components to recognize individual companies or agencies for their work with the Society or on behalf of our various initiatives.

At the end of a term as president, one would like to reflect upon the accomplishments and successes. However, it seems that while you initiate ideas and plans to further the Society, these are rarely accomplished within your year's mandate. Rather, you inherit programs initiated by previous presidents that must be addressed, and which provide satisfaction when brought to fruition.

These individuals have all represented the concerns of their component associations at the national level for the past year, and have contributed greatly to the advancement of the Society nationally and internationally.

Of course, the Executive Committee has provided valuable support and guidance to the Society. Much appreciation is owed to Larry Paterson, FCSLA, Executive Director/Treasurer, and to Don Barron, FCSLA, President-Elect. I advise the intrepid Don Barron to exercise diplomacy and firmness as he embarks upon his presidential term with a focus on establishing reciprocity.

I would also like to provide the membership with an insight into the accomplishments of the Executive Director's office. Larry Paterson and his Executive Assistant, Linda LeGeyt, have demonstrated unselfish dedication which has helped the Society progress immeasurably in terms of its management. Archival material has been unearthed and sorted, meeting minutes transcribed and distributed, agenda and support documents supplied prior to meetings in binder formats, all contributing to increased efficiency in the management and operation of the CSLA.

The Board and Executive are merely organizational elements within a dedicated network of many committees and volunteers of the Society. The real achievements are a result of work undertaken by the various committees which report on their progress to the Board and receive feedback and direction. - ❖ Replacement of cash awards with Student Silver Medal Awards and Certificates. The minted medal will be available for Spring '94 Graduation.
- ❖ International Initiatives review, and provision of financial assistance to projects benefitting the profession or illustrating Canadian landscape architectural expertise.
- ❖ Recognition of excellence through CSLA Awards. This year the Professional Awards Program attracted 38 submissions and the three days of judging produced thirteen regional awards and five national awards.
- ❖ Recognition of dedication through Service Awards. This program has expanded to recognize the continued dedication of members as well as the merit of corporations' and individuals' work in protecting or enhancing the global environment.
- ❖ Initiation of the Ambassador Program by the CSLA External Affairs Committee. The Committee has now received names of individual members who will become liaisons and ambassadors within other organizations on behalf of the CSLA.
- ❖ Development of guidelines for expenditures of the Executive.
- ❖ A review of Fellows induction ceremonies and their ribbon colours.
- ❖ Discussions of the Congress planner document and of future Congresses culminating in a joint CSLA/ASLA Congress in the year 2000.
- ❖ Investigation of the potential for reciprocity with the ASLA accreditation process.
- ❖ The continued review of LARE and its influence on reciprocity among component associations.

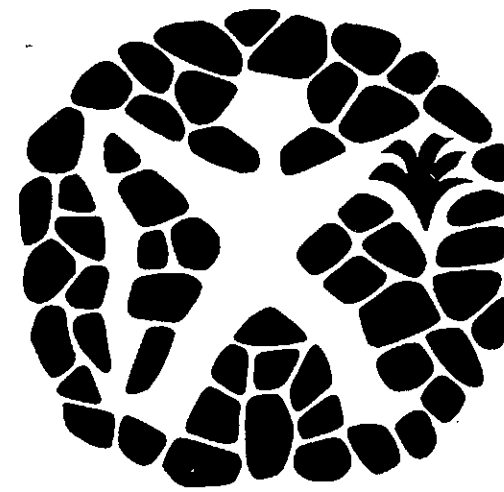
